City of Ottawa tax freeze unnecessary and cruel

The City of Ottawa tax freeze trumpeted in the May 6 article, "Ottawa evades tax pain," may be the cruelest and most unnecessary political act in council history. People who own homes valued at \$150,000 will save \$4 per year for every per cent that taxes might have gone up. Wealthy property owners will save more. However, the majority of Ottawa residents do not own their homes - they just pay for them. To achieve the dubious milestone, council cut funding to the only organization that sepcifically is for tenants. This may prove to be the final nail in the coffin for the Federation of Ottawa Carleton Tenants Association (observe who is cheering).

The savings for taxpayers in this cut will be about 15 cents per year. Meanwhile, tenants will continue to pay double the rate of property taxation through the rent. Ironically, the annual rent guidelines set by the Harris Government factors in a 1.57 per cent increase in municipal taxes.

Citizens, and that still includes tenants, should note that this cut was not recommended in the draft budget, was not called for by any presenter to council in the pre-budget meetings, and that the funding was for a purchase of service contract and not a grant. Further, none of the councillors who abandoned their support for the Tenants Federation had the decency to contact the organization to discuss this matter.

Mayor Jim Waston, 🤪 in defending his own office budget, said that his phone is always ringing. So is the phone at the federation. I suggest tenants now call the mayor (244-5380) when they can't get service from the Tenants Federation.
